After two years of waiting, the children have been able to return to the residential section which has been renovated through a grant from USAid. On 13 October we will be having an opening ceremony which will be attended by the the Governor of the district. We thank God for the space that this gives us for looking after more young people but remain in urgent need of volunteers to care for the children.
